

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Tizig Pharma Pvt. Ltd., Kathmandu Nepal

And

Rotary Club of Kasthamandap, Kathmandu Nepal

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 18 July 2026 between **Tizig Pharma Pvt. Ltd.**, (herein referred to as Company) having registered office at Kathmandu Municipality, ward no. 5, Maligaun, Kathmandu, Nepal

and

Rotary Club of Kasthamandap (hereafter referred Rotary Club) having registered office at 22-23 Wans, Khechpokhari, Heeng House, Kathmandu.

Collectively referred to as the "Parties".

1. Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is executed to establish a collaborative framework whereby the Company shall, subject to the terms of this MOU, provide cancer medicines manufactured by the Company to financially deprived cancer patients at discounted prices or free of cost upon the recommendation of the Rotary Club.

2. Objectives

The objectives of this MOU are to:

- Improve access to life-saving anti-cancer medicines for economically disadvantaged patients.
- Promote humanitarian healthcare initiatives through collaboration between the Parties.
- Establish a transparent, accountable, and equitable patient assistance mechanism.

3. Scope of Collaboration

3.1 Responsibilities of Tizig Company

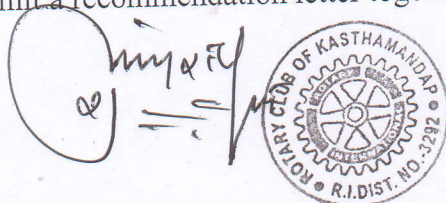
The Company shall:

- Review recommendations received from the Rotary Club.
- Provide prescribed medicines if manufactured by the Company (subject to stock availability)
- Determine, at its sole discretion, whether medicines shall be supplied at a discounted price or free of cost.
- Maintain records of all medicines supplied under this MOU.
- Ensure that medicines supplied comply with applicable regulatory standards.

3.2 Responsibilities of Rotary Club of Kasthamandap

The Rotary Club shall:

- Identify deserving patients requiring financial assistance.
- Verify the financial condition of patients to the best of its ability.
- Submit a recommendation letter together with:



Handwritten signature.



- Prescription from the treating oncologist/physician.
- Document confirming cancer diagnosis.
- Proof of financial hardship, where available (recommendation of respective ward office).
- Copy of citizenship or other identification.
- Any additional documents requested by the Company.
- Ensure recommendations are genuine and made solely for humanitarian purposes.

4. Eligibility

A patient should ordinarily:

- Have a confirmed diagnosis of cancer.
- Be prescribed a medicine manufactured by the Company.
- Demonstrate financial hardship.
- Submit complete supporting documents.

5. Patient Assistance Approval

Recommendations made by the Rotary Club shall not automatically entitle any patient to receive assistance.

The Company shall independently review each application, and its decision regarding eligibility, quantity of medicine, duration of support, and the amount of discount or free supply shall be final (The Company reserves the right to approve or reject any application).

6. Financial Arrangement

- 6.1 The Parties agree that the **maximum aggregate value of assistance** (discounts and/or medicines supplied free of cost) under this MOU shall **not exceed NPR 500,000 (Nepalese Rupees Five Lakhs Only)** during its validity.
- 6.2 The Company shall monitor utilization of the financial limit and maintain records for the same.
- 6.3 Once the cumulative value of assistance reaches **NPR 500,000**, the obligations of the Company under this MOU shall automatically cease unless both Parties mutually agree in writing to increase the limit or execute a fresh MOU.
- 6.4 The Rotary Club shall not be entitled to any commission, service charge, reimbursement, or financial benefit from this arrangement.

7. Availability of Medicines

Supply of medicines shall always remain subject to:

- Availability of stock of respective medicine.
- Manufacturing schedules.
- Regulatory approvals.
- Company's internal patient assistance policies.

The Company shall not be liable for non-availability of medicines.



8. Monitoring

The Rotary Club shall maintain a register of all patients recommended under this MOU.

The Company shall maintain records of medicines supplied.

Either Party may review implementation of this MOU through periodic meetings.

9. Confidentiality

Both Parties shall maintain confidentiality of all patient information and shall use such information solely for implementation of this MOU, except where disclosure is required by law or with the patient's consent.

10. Publicity

Neither Party shall use the name, logo, trademark, or goodwill of the other Party for publicity or promotional purposes without prior written consent.

11. Term

This MOU shall be effective from **1 July 2026** and shall remain in force until **30 June 2027**, unless terminated earlier in accordance with this MOU or may be stopped due to financial limit mentioned in clause 6.1 of this MOU.

12. Termination

Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving **30 (thirty) days' prior written notice**.

Termination shall not affect assistance already approved before the date of termination unless otherwise mutually agreed.

13. No Partnership

Nothing contained in this MOU shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, agency, employment relationship, or any legal relationship other than that expressly set forth herein.

14. Indemnity

The Rotary Club shall ensure that all recommendations are made in good faith based on the information available. The Company shall not be responsible for any inaccurate information submitted by applicants or recommended by the Rotary Club.

15. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

This MOU shall be governed by the laws of Nepal.

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall first be resolved through amicable consultation. If unresolved within thirty (30) days, the dispute shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of Kathmandu, Nepal.

16. Amendment

No amendment or modification of this MOU shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by the authorized representatives of both Parties.

17. Entire Understanding

This MOU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties regarding the subject matter and supersedes all prior discussions or understandings.
